Tour Itinerary:

DAY 1- Arusha

- Arrive at Kilimanjaro International Airport [JRO] where you are met and transferred to your hotel located a short distance from Arusha Town Center
- Overnight at the Four Points by Sheraton Arusha
- Bed and breakfast provided

DAY 2- Lake Manyara National Park

- Your morning is at leisure and safari briefing followed by lunch.
- In the afternoon, you depart Arusha passing through the Masai Steppe filled with many picturesque African villages as well as maize, coffee and banana plantations.
- At the town of Makuyuni you turn North West and continue the journey up through a scenic escarpment that brings you to your lodge, perched on the edge of the Rift Valley with stunning views over the distant Lake Manyara.
- Overnight at Lake Manyara Kilimamoja Lodge
- Full board provided

DAY 3- Central Serengeti

- After breakfast there is a game drive in Lake Manyara National Park that returns to the lodge for lunch.

- Leaving Lake Manyara behind, the journey continues North West across the stunning hilly countryside of the highlands which is filled with wheat and coffee plantations, and then into the Ngorongoro Conservation Area.
- From here lie the vast plains of the Serengeti, where you'll hopefully start spotting game well before you get into the park.
- Overnight at the Serengeti Sopa Lodge
- Full board provided

DAY 4- Central Serengeti

- Morning and afternoon game drives in Serengeti National Park
- Overnight at the Serengeti Sopa Lodge
- Full board provided

Optional Hot Air Balloon Safari in Serengeti National Park

Depart the lodge before sunrise and transfer by the balloon safari company's vehicle (with other travelers) to the balloon staging site. After a briefing from the pilot, the crew will inflate the envelope. At sunrise, begin your ballooning adventure with flights at elevations to provide an overview of Serengeti National Park and a close look at the wildlife. After about 50 minutes, land and the chase crew transfer you to a private site where a bush breakfast complete with bubbly to celebrate the successful flight in the tradition of balloonists over the centuries. Transfer to your lodge or a mid-location where you meet your driver guide.

DAY 5- Ngorongoro Crater

- After breakfast, you depart for Ngorongoro, viewing game across the vast Serengeti plains, and stopping off en route for your picnic lunch.
- You then continue your journey towards Ngorongoro where you visit a Masai Village before you continue to your lodge, set high on the rim of Ngorongoro Crater.
- Overnight at Ngorongoro Sopa Lodge
- Full board provided

DAY 6- Ngorongoro Crater

- A highlight awaits you this morning as you depart to explore what is commonly referred to as the World's largest wildlife zoo.
- After breakfast, you descend with a picnic lunch through the early morning mists and 2,000 feet into the crater.
- Ngorongoro Crater is the world's largest intact volcanic caldera. Due to its size and diversity, the crater floor is comprised of several distinct areas, ranging from forest, swamps, lakes and springs, to open grassland and some sandy dunes. It's an awesome wildlife experience.
- Lunch is served near a small lake filled with hippos.
- You then continue game viewing before returning to the crater's rim and your lodge.
- Overnight at Ngorongoro Serena Lodge
- Full board provided

DAY 7- Tarangire National Park

- Departing Ngorongoro Crater after breakfast, head south east past Lake Manyara and Mto wa Mbu village.
- Through the highlands and the Karatu district, you'll view the scenic wheat plains and coffee plantations here before journeying down the spectacular escarpment where you turn south on to the main Arusha – Dodoma road and into the park.
- From here to the lodge, you'll enjoy a game drive en route.
- After lunch and perhaps a swim, the remainder of the afternoon will be spent on a game drive.
- Overnight at Tarangire Sopa Lodge
- Full board provided

DAY 8- End of Itinerary

- Depart after breakfast and head north east to Arusha.
- On arrival in Arusha, you will be provided lunch followed by a transfer to the Kilimanjaro International Airport [JRO] to connect with your international departure flight.
